

## <u>Bathurst Public School</u> <u>2014 Enrolment Ceiling Policy</u>

At a meeting held with community representatives at the P&C meeting held in February 2014, a joint school community decision was made to continue to place enrolment ceilings on each class K-6 at Bathurst Public School for the 2014 school year.

This decision follows the guidelines set out in the DEC Enrolment Policy for Public Schools and the agreement regarding zoning implemented by the schools in the Bathurst Schools Group.

The ceiling would be the enrolment number in each class with a buffer for new local students who live within the Bathurst Public School drawing area.

The enrolment for each class for 2014:

- Kindergarten 20 children in each class with a buffer of 1 student per class for new local students who live within the Bathurst Public School drawing area. Enrolments should not exceed 20 students as per the class size reduction program although 1 class has 21 children and the other 3 classes has 20 children as of 19/1/14.
- Year 1 21 children in each class with a buffer of 1 child per class for new local students who live within the Bathurst Public School drawing area. Enrolments should not exceed 22 in each year 1 class as per the class size reduction program. As of 19/2/14, one class has 21, one class has 20, one class has 22 and the year 1/2 has 22 children.
- Year 2 23 children in each class with a buffer of 1 child per class for new local students who live within the Bathurst Public School drawing area. Enrolments should not exceed 24 in each year 2 class as per the class size reduction program. One year 2 class has 25 children, one year 2 class has 24 children and the 1/2 class has 22 children as of 19/2/14.
- Year 3/4 29 children in each class with a buffer of 1 child per class for new local students who live within the Bathurst Public School drawing area. As of 19/2/14, 3

classes have 28 children and 1 class has 27 children. Class sizes should not exceed 30 children.

- Year 4/5 29 children in each class with a buffer of 1 child per class for new local students who live within the Bathurst Public School drawing area. As of 19/2/14, the 4/5 class has 28 children. Class sizes should not exceed 30 children.
- Year 5/6 29 children in each class with a buffer of 1 child per class for new local students who live within the Bathurst Public School drawing area. As of 19/2/14, all 3 classes have 29 children. Class sizes should not exceed 30 children.

These ceilings have been endorsed by our school community for the 2014 school year.
